Why do we give offerings to the church? Two main reasons include: 1) we believe in God and 2) we believe the church is making a difference.

First, we believe in God through the gift of faith. The root of the Greek word for faith, *pistis* is from the verb *peithô* ("to persuade, be persuaded") which supplies the *essence* of faith. Through Jesus, God has **persuaded** us that we are *loved* beyond measure. *Forgiven* from a broken past. *Assured* of a future with God in heaven. And *set free* to live with conviction, compassion, and creativity. Through pure grace, we are persuaded to live lives of commitment, grounded in community, and reaching out to a world hungry for connection.

And secondly, we believe the church is making a difference. What a blessing it has been to hear the testimonies during our "Faith Is..." worship series this past month. Thank you to Theresa, Anna-Kari, Jeanne, Bianka, and confirmands Joe, Hayden, and Erin for inspiring us to treasure our faith. Be encouraged by an excerpt from one of our 9th graders, Hayden:

Pilgrim is such a place of enjoyment for me, because Pilgrim is a family that cares. I learned in confirmation it's easy to lose yourself if you don't stay in touch with God. Now that I've been in high school for 3 months, I can see how people can be corrupted by getting caught up *in things that don't matter*. The most important thing that I keep with me is always to stay in touch with God no matter where I go.

I love Hayden's pastoral warning to avoid "getting caught up in things that don't matter." Faith is what matters.

It's been a very positive fall so far at Pilgrim... we have had 7 prospective families come to tour the school in October alone, and we have 5 families that are currently attending new member classes, preparing to join in November. We now have four small groups meeting in homes, a new format for our Sunday School, and the added energy of our seminarians learning among us, Hans and Marissa. We are looking forward to a strong holiday season of growth and impact!

Because Anna-Kari and I believe in God and believe that Pilgrim is making a difference, we are increasing our tithes in our worship offerings to \$620 a month, and are increasing our commitment to the Capital Campaign to \$150 a month. We have chosen to give electronically... it is more convenient for us and more beneficial to Pilgrim.

We hope you will prayerfully consider the ways God is inspiring you to give in this season of gratitude and fruitfulness!

Pilgrim Financials: At a glance

Overall:

Thanks to the strong leadership and generosity of many, we ended 2014 with a greatly minimized deficit. We ended our last fiscal period, a "stump" year (January through June 2015) \$7,947 in the black. This year, as we find ourselves four months into our new fiscal year schedule (July '15 to June '16), we are currently in the black.

School Finances:

Thanks to the commitment of our teachers, strong leadership, a slight increase in enrollment vs. projections, and generous giving, we are currently on pace overall. We have collected \$229,875 in tuition so far, which is above our projected budget number of \$208,037. However, there are three factors to keep in mind. 1) The tuition assistance fund is currently at \$24,056, and we have committed financial aid and staff discounts totaling \$49,797. 2) We have a handful of families who have paid this school year's tuition up front, and 3) we have been informed that in January of 2016, our staff's health benefits will be increasing by 14% and disability benefits will increased by 2%. We are thankful for all the members, friends, parents, and alumni who are giving to our tuition assistance fund.

Worship Offerings: While our September 2015 offerings were higher than our September 2014 numbers, our 1st quarter total is short of expectations, having received \$31,319 through September 30th, which is under our budgeted, year-to-date expectations of \$41,250. We are grateful for all who choose to make larger offerings as the calendar year comes to an end.

Growing Forward Capital Campaign 2015-2017: As of September 30th, we have received \$55,978 in contributions toward our goal of raising \$300,000 for much needed improvements. Completed projects include installing new carpet tiles in our classrooms, phase one of our new playground renovation, Energy saving retrofitting to our lighting, and lead mitigation work in our teacherages. If we were to be on pace with our receipts, we would be approaching \$100,000 in receipts as we approach the end of the calendar year... your generosity is appreciated.
