Welcome to the Season of the Holy Spirit! The church celebrates Pentecost this year, starting with May 15th, and continuing ALL THE WAY to Christ the King Sunday, the 20th of November. Why do you think the liturgical Gods made Pentecost the longest season?

One reason is because the Holy Spirit has SO MUCH to teach us. God invites us to become students of the Holy Spirit!



It is a lively, rather small space with light wood paneled walls and colorful, stylized pictures on the walls. # Update On Mission Gifts From The Growing Forward Capital Campaign

Thanks to God, Pilgrim Lutheran Growing Forward Capital Campaign raised \$117,811 as of December 31, 2015. Of this total, \$49,538 was rolled over from the previous Capital Campaign and new offerings amounted to \$68,273.

This is something to celebrate! And one of the wonderful goals of our ongoing Pilgrim Campaign is our commitment to give \$5,000 of every \$50,000 raised to God's mission reaching out beyond Pilgrim! Thanks to the generosity of everyone participating in this and the previous Capital Campaign, Pilgrim was able to make possible the following grants in 2015:

\$ 800 for ELCA/World Hunger for digging a well.

\$ 715 for ELCA/Good Gifts for purchasing a family farm for feeding families in need

\$ 300 for ELCA/Good Gifts for two Ambulance Bikes

\$ 400 for ELCA/Good Gifts for School Supplies for a classroom for a year

\$2360 for Pilgrim El Salvador Solar Team to bring electricity to 10 rural homes

\$1000 for Pilgrim El Salvador Farming Hope/Lane Tech Homeland Helpers irrigation project

\$1000 for Hope House Clinic at Homeless Shelter for medicine and supplies

\$1000 for UCAN for development of new Lawndale Campus serving at-risk youth

\$1730 for Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago for Tuition Assistance

\$2000 for Luther North College Prep High School for Tuition Assistance

#### And, so far, in 2016, Church Council has approved the following new grants:

\$ 500 for Coat Angels to keep at least 10 Chicago children warm

\$2000 for Luther North College Prep High School Tuition Assistance

\$2000 for Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Colon, El Salvador, to buy land for their church and its mission to serve refugees

As soon as we raise the next \$31,726, we will have reached \$100,000 in new donations for our Pilgrim Growing Forward Capital Campaign and another \$5,000 will be available to expand the mission of Pilgrim with more Mission Gifts! We pray and encourage everyone to be part of raising this money so that it can be released with our prayers to spread the love of Jesus in this earth and lift many people up!


