
Jingle Dress



The **jingle dress** is a dress decorated with many cones made of tin. When the wearer dances, the cones sound like rain falling.

The jingle dress is attributed to the Ojibwe. The knowledge of the dress and instructions for making the dress came to an Ojibwe man in a recurring dream.

The dream also gave instructions on how to dance in the dress.

The jingle dress is considered a healing tool and believed to be sacred by the Anishnawbe people.
