Aboriginal Family Literacy Circle:

This Circle is a network of Aboriginal and mainstream agencies and service providers who work with families with children from birth to six years. The Circle has met regularly since 2004 for the purpose of developing greater sensitivity and awareness to Aboriginal culture and people, and to support learning and literacy within families and communities.

Current Circle membership includes:

- Ontario Early Years Centres (Family Space, Lennox & Addington Resources for Children, The Child Centre),
- Limestone District School Board,
- Kingston Parenting and Family Literacy Centres,
- Early Literacy Specialists (Kingston Literacy & Skills and Family Space), and
- Aboriginal Healthy Babies Healthy Children

The Circle also receives guidance from Community Health Indigenous Program and Aboriginal Elders.
