Friends of the Middle River will be partnering with Stream Sweepers to perform a stream assessment of the lower part of the Middle River in August. The assessment will be used to geolocate items that need to be cleaned up by Stream Sweepers team in areas where we have not done our own cleanup work in the past following the completion of our assessment. Stream Sweepers is a non-profit that has cleaned up other rivers in Virginia and is looking to help us with the Middle River.

Two person teams will paddle the river with one canoeist documenting the locations of the trash to be removed and the other canoeist paddling the boat. Trash removal is not part of these assessment trips.

A training session for volunteers to assist with the assessment will be held at the Augusta County government Center South Board room from 8 AM to 5 PM on July 30th. Space is limited for the training so please signup to attend prior to the event.
